The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
SECTION 1. G.S. 14-135 reads as rewritten:	
"§ 14-135. Cutting, injuring, or removing another's timber.	
If any person not being the bona fide owner thereof, shall knowingly and willf	fully
cut down, injure or remove any standing, growing or fallen tree or log, the propert	y of
another, he shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor. If the person commits a secon	id or
subsequent offense, and the value of the timber is two thousand five hundred do	llars
(\$2,500) or more, the person shall be guilty of a Class I felony."	
SECTION 2. This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applied	es to
offenses committed on or after that date.
