4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
5	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 115C-296(c1) reads as rewritten:		
6	"(c1) (Expir	res July 1, 2011) The State Board of Community Colleges may provide	
7	a program of study for lateral entry teachers to complete the coursework necessary to		
8	earn a teaching certificate. To this end, the State Board of Education, in consultation		
9	with the State Board of Community Colleges, shall establish a competency-based		
10	program of study for lateral entry teachers to be implemented within the Community		
11	College System no later than May 1, 2006. This program must meet standards set by the		
12	State Board of Education.		
13	The State Board of Community Colleges and the State Board of Education shall		
14	jointly identify the community college courses and the teacher education program		
15	courses that are necessary and appropriate for inclusion in the community college		
16	program of study for lateral entry teachers. To the extent possible, any courses that must		
17	be completed through an approved teacher education program shall be taught on a		
18	community college campus or shall be available through distance learning.		
19	In order to participate in the community college program of study for lateral entry		
20	teachers, an individual <del>must:</del>		
21	(1)	Holdmust hold at least a bachelors degree from a regionally accredited	
22		institution of higher education; education.	
23	(2)	Have completed the bachelors degree at least five years before	
24		undertaking the program of study under this subsection; and	
25		Hold a lateral entry teaching certificate and be employed as a teacher	
26		in a local school administrative unit.

- 2 requirements of certification set by the State Board of Education shall be recommended
  3 for a North Carolina teaching certificate."
- 4 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007, and expires July 1, 5 2011.
