Two years. 9 Within two years – 10 An action brought by the estate of the person injured or a living family 11 (5) member or direct descendant of the person injured, for damages on 12 account of a death, personal injury, or physical damage to property 13 resulting from the November 10, 1898, Wilmington Race Riot; the 14 cause of action shall not accrue until July 1, 2007, and damages 15 awarded under this subdivision are subject to all of the following 16 17 requirements: 18 Prior to awarding damages, inflation, present replacement a. value, and loss of use from November 10, 1898, shall be 19 20 considered. 21 After awarding damages, these damages shall be compounded b. 22 at an eight percent (8%) rate of interest from November 10, 23 1898. 24 After damages are compounded under sub-subdivision b. of this

Act, Chapter 29 of the General Statutes."

SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007, and applies to causes of action filed on or after that date.
