The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:	
S	ECTION 1. G.S. 20-179 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
" <u>(u)</u> A	person convicted of driving while impaired where the aggravating factor
listed in subdivision (d)(1) of this section is found with an alcohol concentration of 0.20	
or more wi	ithin a relevant time after driving in addition to and after any other
punishment imposed:	
<u>(1</u>	Shall serve a minimum mandatory 24-hour active sentence where
	punishment is imposed pursuant to subsections (g) through (k) of this
	section.
<u>(2</u>	Shall serve a minimum mandatory six-month active sentence where
	punishment is imposed pursuant to subsection (g) or (h) of this
	section."
<b>SECTION 2.</b> This act becomes effective December 1, 2007, and applies to	

offenses committed on or after that date.
