11	nonvoting advis	sory members. All the members shall be residents of North Carolina and

15		term of two years.
16	<u>(2)</u>	One voting member shall be appointed by the President Pro Tempore

19		Representatives for an initial term of three years.
20	<u>(4)</u>	Two voting members shall be appointed by the Secretary of Crime
