5	Whereas, since 1988, the State has appropriated funds to the Rural Economic		
6	Development Center, Inc., to provide financial and technical assistance to new and		
7	emerging minority community development corporations to build capacity and grow		
8	their services, including business loans, revitalization of commercial districts,		
9	low-income and moderate-income housing, child care, youth development programs,		
10	job training, long-term community planning, and other activities; and		
11	Whereas, the Community Development Corporations grants program has		
12	grown to include at least 27 corporations each year resulting in a reduction in funds		
13	available for each organization; and		
14	Whereas, funding provided through the Community Development		
15	Corporations grants program has been critical to the success and survival of these		
16	organizations by providing them with needed assistance with organizational, business,		
17	commercial real estate, and housing development activities; Now, therefore,		
18	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

20	development corporation" means a nonprofit corporation:

8	SECTION	1.(b) There is appropriated to the Rural Economic Development	
9	Center, Inc., the sum	of two million five hundred ninety-seven thousand four hundred	
10	ten dollars (\$2,597,4	10) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of two million five	
11	hundred ninety-seven	thousand four hundred ten dollars (\$2,597,410) for the 2008-2009	
12	fiscal year to be allocated as follows:		
13	(1) \$2,5	47,410 in each fiscal year for community development grants to	
14	sup	port development projects and activities within the State's minority	
15	com	munities. Any new or previously funded community development	
16	corp	oration as defined in this section is eligible to apply for funds. The	
17	Rur	al Economic Development Center, Inc., shall establish	
18	perf	ormance-based criteria for determining which community	
19	deve	elopment corporation will receive a grant and the grant amount.	
20	The	Rural Economic Development Center, Inc., shall allocate these	
21	func	ls as follows:

26	(2) \$50	000 in each fiscal year to the Rural Economic Development	
27	Cen	ter, Inc., to be used to cover expenses in administering this section.
