6	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
7	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to The Leaflight,
8	Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the
9	2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2008-2009
10	fiscal year to assist in the development of and the operational and staffing costs of its
11	21st Century Farmers' Markets Program, a pilot program to assist small, low-income
12	North Carolina farmers who market their products directly to customers to enroll in the
13	United States Department of Agriculture Food and Nutrition Service Food Stamp
14	Program, to educate and encourage these farmers to accept noncash customer payments,
15	and to provide educational materials to food stamp recipients; thereby helping these
16	farmers increase their customer base while educating low-income persons about the
17	benefits of having a healthy diet and improved nutrition.
18	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
