A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR COMPREHENSIVE ADOLESCENT  
2 HEALTH CARE CENTERS FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUSTAINING EXISTING  
3 PROGRAMS AND PROVIDING FUNDS FOR START-UP GRANTS IN AREAS  
4 THAT HAVE CRITICAL NEEDS.

6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

7 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
8 Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Public Health, the sum of three  
9 hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$375,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the  
10 sum of three hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$375,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal  
11 year. These funds shall be allocated to eligible school-based and school-linked  
12 adolescent health centers for the purpose of sustaining centers that have been  
13 experiencing a growth in case loads. The funds may also be used to provide start-up  
14 grants for new centers in areas of the State where there are critical needs.

15 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
