2	AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO RENOVATE THE CAROLINA THEATRE
3	IN SPRUCE PINE.
4	Whereas, the Carolina Theatre, a cultural event attraction facility of
5	downtown Spruce Pine, was built in 1937 during the heyday of the Silver Screen; and
6	Whereas, out of the Carolina Theatre the Carolina Barn Dance was
7	broadcasted live on 512 radio stations across the United States. From 1949 until
8	sometime in 1954 the Carolina Barn Dance was broadcasted by radio to every state in
9	the nation, except Washington; and
10	Whereas, the Spruce Pine newspaper archives are full of references to the
11	upcoming plethora of performers: Patsy Cline, Bill Monroe, Hank Snow, Sonny James,
12	Kitty Wells, Chet Atkins, String Bean, to name just a few who later became famous.
13	Other performers included Scotty and Lula Belle Wiseman; and
14	Whereas, the Carolina Theatre is a classic example of theatre architecture of
15	the era and its preservation is significant to downtown Spruce Pine; and
16	Whereas, since then a not-for-profit 501(c)3 has been formed and a
17	restoration plan put into effect. The Carolina Preservation Association, Inc., was formed
18	and a local board selected. The restoration of the old theater is underway and progress is
19	being made on a daily basis; Now, therefore,
20	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
21	SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Carolina
22	Theatre Preservation Association, Inc., a nonprofit organization, the sum of one hundred
23	thousand dollars (\$100,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year for renovation of the Spruce
24	Pine facility.
25	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
