2	AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE SALE OF BLOCKS OF TEN TEN-DAY
3	COASTAL RECREATIONAL FISHING LICENSES.
4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Article 14B of Chapter 113 of the General Statutes is amended
6	by adding a new section to read:
7	" <u>§ 113-174.5. Blocks of 10 Ten-Day Coastal Recreational Fishing Licenses.</u>
8	(a) The resident owner of a vessel that is 26 feet or more in length and that is
9	either documented with the United States Coast Guard or registered with the Wildlife
10	Resources Commission pursuant to G.S. 75A-4 may purchase a block of 10 Ten-Day
11	Resident CRFLs or a block of 10 Ten-Day Nonresident CRFLs issued by the Division.
12	A vessel owner who wishes to obtain a block of 10 Ten-Day CRFLs shall provide the
13	Division with all information required by the Division, including information
14	identifying the vessel on which the Ten-Day CRFLs will be used. Each individual
15	Ten-Day CRFL shall identify the vessel for which the block of 10 Ten-Day CRFLs is
16	issued. An individual Ten-Day CRFL issued as part of a block of 10 Ten-Day CRFLs
17	may only be used on the vessel for which it was issued. An individual Ten-Day CRFL
18	issued as part of a block of 10 Ten-Day CRFLs may not be used on a for hire boat.
19	(b) The fee for a block of 10 Ten-Day Resident CRFLs is seventy-five dollars
20	(\$75.00). An individual Ten-Day Resident CRFL issued as part of a block of 10
21	Ten-Day Resident CRFLs is valid for a period of 10 consecutive days beginning on the
22	date that the license information is recorded as provided by subsection (d) of this
23	section. Only a resident of the State may engage in recreational fishing under the
24	authority of an individual Ten-Day Resident CRFL issued as part of a block of 10
25	Ten-Day Resident CRFLs.
26	(c) The fee for a block of 10 Ten-Day Nonresident CRFLs is one hundred fifty
27	dollars (\$150.00). An individual Ten-Day Nonresident CRFL issued as part of a block
28	of 10 Ten-Day Nonresident CRFLs is valid for a period of 10 consecutive days
29	beginning on the date that the license information is recorded as provided by subsection

1	(d) of this section. Only an individual who is not a resident of the State may engage in
2	recreational fishing under the authority of an individual Ten-Day Nonresident CRFL
3	issued as part of a block of 10 Ten-Day Nonresident CRFLs.
4	(d) Prior to any recreational fishing occurring under the authority of an individual
5	Ten-Day CRFL issued as part of a block of 10 ten Ten-Day CRFLs, the vessel owner
6	who purchased the block of 10 Ten-Day CRFLs shall record the date fishing activity
7	will begin and the name, address, telephone number, and date of birth of the individual
8	who will be fishing under the authority of the individual Ten-Day CRFL.
9	(e) <u>A vessel owner who purchases a block of 10 Ten-Day CRFLs shall comply</u>
10	with all data and information reporting requirements of the Division.
11	(f) <u>A vessel owner who fails to comply with any of the requirements governing</u>
12	the issuance, use, recording, or reporting of blocks of 10 Ten-Day CRFLs will be
13	ineligible to purchase any additional blocks of 10 Ten-Day CRFLs for a period of two
14	years from the date of noncompliance."
15	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective July 1, 2007.
