1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO AMEND THE LAWS PROHIBITING DOG FIGHTING AND BAITING 3 TO ALLOW EARTHDOG TRIALS. 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 5 SECTION 1. G.S. 14-362.2 reads as rewritten: 6 "§ 14-362.2. Dog fighting and baiting. 7 A person who instigates, promotes, conducts, is employed at, provides a dog (a) 8 for, allows property under the person's ownership or control to be used for, gambles on, or profits from an exhibition featuring the baiting of a dog or the fighting of a dog with 9 another dog or with another animal is guilty of a Class H felony. A lease of property 10 that is used or is intended to be used for an exhibition featuring the baiting of a dog or 11 12 the fighting of a dog with another dog or with another animal is void, and a lessor who 13 knows this use is made or is intended to be made of the lessor's property is under a duty 14 to evict the lessee immediately. A person who owns, possesses, or trains a dog with the intent that the dog be 15 (b) 16 used in an exhibition featuring the baiting of that dog or the fighting of that dog with 17 another dog or with another animal is guilty of a Class H felony. A person who participates as a spectator at an exhibition featuring the baiting 18 (c) 19 of a dog or the fighting of a dog with another dog or with another animal is guilty of a 20 Class H felony. 21 This section does not prohibit the use of dogs in the lawful taking of animals (d) under the jurisdiction and regulation of the Wildlife Resources Commission. 22 23 This section does not prohibit the use of dogs in earthdog trials that are (e) 24 sanctioned or sponsored by the American Kennel Club, the American Working Terrier 25 Association, or the United Kennel Club. Quarry at an earthdog trial shall at all times be 26 kept separate from the dogs by a sturdy barrier, such as a cage, and have access to food 27 and water.

1 **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
