A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE T.E.A.C.H. EARLY CHILDHOOD  
PROJECT.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the  
Department of Health and Human Services the sum of two hundred thousand dollars  
(\$200,000) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year. These funds shall be used to support the  
T.E.A.C.H. Early Childhood Project by assisting with new scholarships and inflationary  
costs.

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2008.
