February 22, 2007 1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 2 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE REPORT OF AN ACCIDENT INVOLVING A MOTOR 3 VEHICLE AND A BICYCLE WHERE THE TOTAL PROPERTY DAMAGE 4 EXCEEDS FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS. 5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: 6 **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-4.01(33b) reads as rewritten: "(33b) Reportable Crash. – A crash involving a motor vehicle that results in 7 8 one or more of the following: Death or injury of a human being. 9 a. Total property damage of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) or 10 b. more, or property damage of any amount to a vehicle seized 11 12 pursuant to G. S. 20-28.3. Total property damage of five hundred dollars (\$500.00) or 13 <u>c.</u> more and involves a bicycle as defined in G.S. 20-171.8(1)." 14

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
