A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE A NONCITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES WHO IS PRESENT IN THE UNITED STATES TO PRESENT A VALID PASSPORT FROM THE COUNTRY OF ORIGIN AND VALID DOCUMENTATION SHOWING LEGAL PRESENCE ISSUED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT TO RECEIVE A DRIVERS LICENSE FROM THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES. (4) 6 (5) A receipt for real property taxes paid to a North Carolina locality. 7 A current automobile insurance policy issued to the applicant and (6) 8 showing the applicant's address. 9 (7) A monthly or quarterly financial statement from a North Carolina 10 regulated financial institution. 11 A matricula consular or substantially similar document issued by the (8) 12 Mexican Consulate for North Carolina. 13 A document similar to that described in subsection (8) of this section, (9) 14 issued by the consulate or embassy of another country. Issuance and renewal of drivers licenses. 19 20 Duration and Renewal of Licenses. - Drivers licenses shall be issued and 21 (f) 22 renewed pursuant to the provisions of this subsection. 23 24 Duration of license. – A drivers license that was issued by the Division (3) 25 26 27 28 29 30 31
 - and is renewed by the Division expires at the end of the period provided by this subsection after the expiration date of the license that is renewed unless the Division determines that a license of shorter duration should be issued when the applicant holds a visa of limited duration from the United States Department of Homeland Security, presents a valid passport from the country of origin and valid documentation demonstrating legal presence in the United States and that documentation is issued to the applicant under the authority of the United States Government, but in no event shall the license expire later than the applicant's lawful presence in the United States. A person may apply to the Division to renew a license during the 180-day period before the license expires. The Division may not accept an application for renewal made before the 180-day period begins.

SECTION 4. G.S. 20-7(s) reads as rewritten:

"§ 20-7. Issuance and renewal of drivers licenses.

Notwithstanding the requirements of subsection (b1) of this section that an applicant present a valid social security number, the Division shall issue a drivers license of limited duration, under subsection (f) of this section, to an applicant present in
