8	<u>(a)</u> <u>Th</u>	e General Assembly finds that, for reasons of general health and safety,
9	employees should be permitted to stop work at least once during the shift or workday	
10	for nutritional purposes.	
11	<u>(b)</u> <u>Th</u>	e Commissioner of Labor shall adopt rules to provide that, at a minimum,
12	every employer must allow each employee to take at least one work break for a meal	
13	during the employee's workday or shift."
