AN ACT TO STUDY THE FEASIBILITY OF TELEVISING ALL LEGISLATIVE
SESSIONS AND SELECTED COMMITTEE MEETINGS.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** The Legislative Services Commission shall study the 6 feasibility of televising all House of Representatives and Senate sessions and selected 7 committee meetings and, in conducting the study, may appoint an advisory committee 8 composed of members of the Legislative Services Commission, other legislators, and 9 members of the public. The study shall also include the feasibility of streaming video 10 content over the Internet. The Commission shall report to the 2007 Regular Session of 11 the General Assembly no later than May 1, 2008.

12 **SECTION 2.** The study shall include various options for handling the 13 project, including the UNC Center for Public Television and the Agency for Public 14 Telecommunications. The study shall examine newer technologies for more 15 cost-efficient means of handling the broadcasts.

16 **SECTION 3.** The Legislative Services Commission shall allocate funds 17 appropriated to the General Assembly for the 2007-2008 fiscal year to conduct the 18 study.
