Article 3 of Chapter 40A of the General Statutes is amended 8 by adding a new section to read: 9 "§ 40A-57. Attorneys' fees. 10 If the final judgment is greater than the amount deposited by the condemnor 11 pursuant to this Article, the owner shall be entitled to attorneys' fees and costs of court." 12 SECTION 2. Article 2 of Chapter 40A of the General Statutes is amended 13 by adding a new section to read: 14 "§ 40A-35. Attorneys' fees. 15 If the final judgment is greater than the amount deposited by the condemnor 16 pursuant to this Article, the owner shall be entitled to attorneys' fees and costs of court." **SECTION 3.** Article 9 of Chapter 136 of the General Statutes is amended by 17 adding a new section to read: 18 19 "§ 136-121.2. Attorneys' fees. 20 If the final judgment is greater than the amount deposited by the condemnor 21 pursuant to this Article, the owner shall be entitled to attorneys' fees and costs of court." 22 **SECTION 4.** This act becomes effective October 1, 2007.
