A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND
HUMAN SERVICES, OFFICE OF RURAL HEALTH, FOR RECRUITMENT
ACTIVITIES.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 7 Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Rural Health, the sum of two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and 8 9 the sum of two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) for the 2008-2009 10 fiscal year. These funds shall be used for the Rural Obstetrical Care Incentive Fund in the Office of Rural Health to make grants to physicians who are adversely affected by 11 12 the high cost of professional liability insurance. Grant funds shall be allocated solely 13 for the purpose of subsidizing in whole or in part the costs associated with obtaining or 14 maintaining professional liability insurance for physicians in health care manpower 15 shortage areas of the State as defined by the Office of Rural Health.

16 **SECTION 2.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to the 17 Department of Health and Human Services, Office of Rural Health, the sum of one 18 million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and 19 the sum of one million four hundred thousand dollars (\$1,400,000) for the 2008-2009 20 fiscal year. These funds shall be used for recruitment incentives and practice support 21 incentives for physicians who are practicing or who intend to practice in health 22 manpower shortage areas of the State.
