5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	SECTION 1. The North Carolina Child Fatality Task Force shall study and
7	analyze the feasibility of the use of safety restraints by passengers on school buses and
8	school activity buses. In conducting the study, the Task Force shall consider:
9	(1) A determination whether safety restraints are necessary to enhance the
10	safety of passengers on school buses;
11	(2) An evaluation of the cost of requiring passenger restraint systems on
12	buses to be purchased, leased, or contracted for use on or after July 1,
13	2009;
14	(3) An evaluation of the cost of installing passenger restraint systems on
15	buses currently owned and operated by local boards of education; and
16	(4) The manner by which the local boards of education may enforce the
17	use of safety restraints by passengers on school buses and school
18	activity buses.
19	The Task Force shall report its findings and recommendations, including recommended
20	legislation to the 2008 Regular Session of the 2007 General Assembly on or before May
21	1, 2008.
22	SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
