11A by Section 1 of this act shall be filled by appointment of the Governor for the

1 remainder of the term expiring January 1, 2009. A district attorney for District 11A shall 2 be elected in the 2008 election for a four-year term commencing January 1, 2009. 3 **SECTION 3.** G.S. 7A-69 reads as rewritten: 4 "§ 7A-69. Investigatorial assistants. 5 The district attorney in prosecutorial districts 1, 3B, 4, 5, 7, 8, 11, <u>11A, 11B,</u> 12, 13, 6 14, 15A, 15B, 16A, 18, 19B, 20A, 20B, 21, 22, 24, 25, 26, 27A, 27B, 28, 29A, 29B, and 7 30 is entitled to one investigatorial assistant, and the district attorney in prosecutorial 8 district 10 is entitled to two investigatorial assistants, to be appointed by the district 9 attorney and to serve at his pleasure. 10 It shall be the duty of the investigatorial assistant to investigate cases preparatory to 11 trial and to perform such other Duties as may be assigned by the district attorney. The 12 investigatorial assistant is entitled to reimbursement for his subsistence and travel 13 expenses to the same extent as State employees generally." 14 SECTION 4. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Judicial 15 Department the sum of four hundred sixty-nine thousand one hundred ninety-nine 16

dollars (\$469,199) for the 2007-2008 fiscal year and the sum of five hundred sixty-two
thousand five hundred thirteen dollars (\$562,513) for the 2008-2009 fiscal year to
implement the provisions of this act.
