5	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
6	<b>SECTION 1.</b> G.S. 105-175(21) reads as rewritten:
7	"§ 105-275. Property classified and excluded from the tax base.
8	The following classes of property are hereby designated special classes under
9	authority of Article V, Sec. 2(2), of the North Carolina Constitution and shall not be
10	listed, appraised, assessed, or taxed:
11	
12	(21) The first thirty eight thousand dollars (\$38,000) in assessed value of
13	housing together with the necessary land therefor, owned and used as a
14	residence by Real and personal property belonging to a disabled
15	veteran who receives benefits under 38 U.S.C. § 2101. This exclusion
16	shall be the total amount of the exclusion applicable to such property."
17	SECTION 2. This act is effective for taxes imposed for taxable years
18	beginning on or after July 1, 2007.
