4	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
5	SECTION 1. Article 1A of Chapter 67 of the General Statutes is amended
6	by adding a new section to read:
7	" <u>§ 67-4.6. Owner required to have insurance.</u>
8	(a) Within 30 days of the determination by animal control authorities that a dog
9	is a dangerous dog or a potentially dangerous dog under G.S. 67-4.1(a), the owner of the
10	dog shall obtain, and upon demand present to an animal control officer evidence of, a
11	policy of insurance in the amount of at least one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000)
12	issued by an insurer authorized to do business in this State insuring the owner of the dog
13	against liability for any personal injuries inflicted or other damage caused by the dog.
14	(b) Failure to obtain the insurance required by this section or to produce evidence
15	of that insurance upon demand of an animal control officer is a Class 1 misdemeanor."
16	SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2007, and applies to acts
17	occurring on or after that date.
