**BILL SUMMARY:** The Bill requires the Division of Motor Vehicles to verify that the driver license applicant's social security number matches to the individual applying for the driver license. Also, additional documents are added to the list of documents allowed in verifying residency. The bill allows Division of Motor Vehicles to issue a driver license of limited duration to individuals who hold a valid passport and documents demonstrating legal presence in the United States.

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:** The Division of Motor Vehicles managers stated that these changes in this bill are current practice and will have no impact on current services provided. There is no fiscal impact on the budget since Division of Motor Vehicles currently verifies the documents required in this bill.
