**EFFECTIVE DATE**: When the bill becomes law.

**BILL SUMMARY**: Amends GS 136-28.4 to establish a participation goal of 10% for minority businesses and 5% for women businesses. Requires DOT to try to award minority business at least 10% by value and to award women at least 5% by value of contracts let by DOT for the design, construction, alteration, or maintenance of state highways, roads, streets, or bridges and for the procurement of materials. Requires DOT to adopt written procedures for reaching these goals. Requires DOT to give equal opportunity for contracts to all contractors and businesses *Source: Adapted from Bill Digest H.B. 516 (03/06/0200)*.
