**BILL SUMMARY:** Amends GS 113A-118(f) to waive Coastal Area Management Act emergency permit fees.

**ASSUMPTIONS AND METHODOLOGY:** Since 1999, only eight (8) Major Permits have been authorized under the provisions of G.S. 113A-118(f); an average of one permit each year is authorized under this Statute. Seven of the eight permits issued were assessed a \$400 fee and one was assessed at \$250 fee. Thus, Fiscal Research estimates that waiving CAMA permit fees under G.S. 113A-118(f) would result in a \$400 loss of fee revenue annually.
