4 **"ADJUSTMENTS TO JUDICIAL DEPARTMENT FUNDING**

5 **SECTION 15.17J.(a)** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the
6 Administrative Office of the Courts shall eliminate eight positions that have been vacant for
7 over 200 days, totaling the sum of four hundred seventy-eight thousand four hundred seventy
8 dollars (\$478,470).

9 **SECTION 15.17J.(b)** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, mileage
10 reimbursement for regular superior court judges shall be as provided in G.S. 7A-44(a), and the
11 sum of ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) is restored to the Judicial Department's budget to
12 fully fund that mileage reimbursement.";

14 and on page 209, line 20, by inserting the following on that line:

15 **"FUNDING FOR NC LEAF**

16 **SECTION 16.8.** Notwithstanding any other provision of this act, the sum of three
17 hundred eighty-eight thousand four hundred seventy dollars (\$388,470) resulting from the net
18 reduction to the Judicial Department's budget pursuant to Section 15.17J of this act shall be
19 used to provide funds for the Department of Justice to restore funding to the North Carolina
20 Legal Education Assistance Fund.";
