- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 18C-141 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:
- 6 "(d) The Commission may not contract with as a lottery game retailer any establishment
- where the majority of its business, not including lottery sales, is the cashing of checks, drafts,
 or money orders."
 - **SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
