)	SI	ECTION 2. G.S. 14-360(b) reads as rewritten:
1	"(b) If	any person shall maliciously torture, mutilate, maim, cruelly beat, disfigure,
2	poison, or kill, or cause or procure to be tortured, mutilated, maimed, cruelly beaten, disfigured,	
3	poisoned, or killed, any animal, every such offender shall for every such offense be guilty of a	
1	Class I Class H felony. However, nothing in this section shall be construed to increase the	
5	penalty for cockfighting provided for in G.S. 14-362."	
5		ECTION 3. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of
7		the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) for the 2010-2011 fiscal year to
