## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE KIDS VOTING OF NORTH CAROLINA3 PROGRAM.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to Kids Voting of North
Carolina, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for
the 2010-2011 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:
(1) \$40,000 to be used by the State program to provide services and support and

- (1) \$40,000 to be used by the State program to provide services and support and to implement new Kids Voting programs with local support across the State.
- 10(2)\$160,000 to be divided on the basis of North Carolina Department of Public11Instructions' Average Daily Membership with a minimum of one thousand12dollars (\$1,000) to assist the following counties with their Kids Voting13programs: Alleghany, Beaufort, Buncombe, Burke, Cabarrus, Catawba,14Chowan, Clay, Cumberland, Davie, Durham, Forsyth, Greene, Guilford,15Haywood, Henderson, Iredell, Jackson, Lee, Madison, Mecklenburg, New16Hanover, Pitt, Randolph, and Wake.

17 **SECTION 2.** If a county that received funds under subdivision (2) of Section 1 of 18 this act determines it does not need all of its funding, the county may remit any portion of the 19 funds received to the State program for further expansion of the Kids Voting program to 20 nonparticipating counties.

21 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
