SESSION LAW 2010-55 HOUSE BILL 2042

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF SANFORD TO CONVEY BY PRIVATE SALE ITS REMAINING INTEREST IN A PARCEL OF LAND; AND TO PROVIDE THAT THE CITY OF KING MAY PROHIBIT THE ISSUANCE OF A BUILDING PERMIT TO A DELINQUENT TAXPAYER.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

SECTION 1. The City of Sanford may convey by private sale all remaining interest it may have in the property described in a deed found at Deed Book 549, page 415, in the Lee County Register of Deeds Office, to the Grantee described in that deed.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of Session Law 2009-68 reads as rewritten:

"SECTION 1. This act applies only to the <u>City of King and to the Towns of Columbia and</u> Edenton."

SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
