SENATE BILL 1038

Short Title: Concealed Carry List/Not Public Record. (Public)

Sponsors: Senators Brock; Berger of Rockingham, Hunt, and Tillman.

1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
2 AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT THE LIST OF PERSONS WHO OBTAIN A CONCEALED
3 HANDGUN PERMIT AND OTHER INFORMATION RELATED TO THE PERMIT
4 APPLICATION ARE NOT PUBLIC RECORDS.

5 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

6 SECTION 1. G.S. 14-415.7 reads as rewritten:

7 "**§ 14-415.17. Permit; sheriff to retain and make available to law enforcement agencies a**
8 **list of ~~permittees~~, permittees; list of permittees and other permit information is**
9 **not a public record.**

10 The permit shall be in a certificate form, as prescribed by the Administrative Office of the
11 Courts, that is approximately the size of a North Carolina drivers license. It shall bear the
12 signature, name, address, date of birth, and social security number of the permittee, and the
13 drivers license identification number used in applying for the permit. The sheriff shall maintain
14 a listing of those persons who are issued a permit and any pertinent information regarding the
15 issued permit. The permit information shall be available upon request to all State and local law
16 enforcement ~~agencies~~-agencies; however, the permit information and the list of permittees are
17 not public records as defined by G.S. 132-1 and shall not be subject to inspection and
18 examination under G.S. 132-6.

19 Within five days of the date a permit is issued, the sheriff shall send a copy of the permit to
20 the State Bureau of Investigation. The State Bureau of Investigation shall make this information
21 available to law enforcement officers and clerks of court on a statewide ~~system~~-system;
22 however, this information is not a public record as defined by G.S. 132-1 and shall not be
23 subject to inspection and examination under G.S. 132-6."

24 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective October 1, 2009.
