1 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE KIDS VOTING OF NORTH CAROLINA  
3 PROGRAM.

4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Kids Voting of North  
6 Carolina, Inc., a nonprofit corporation, the sum of two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) for  
7 the 2010-2011 fiscal year to be allocated as follows:

8 (1) \$40,000 to be used by the State program to provide services and support and  
9 to implement new Kids Voting programs with local support across the State.

10 (2) \$160,000 to be divided on the basis of North Carolina Department of Public  
11 Instructions' Average Daily Membership with a minimum of one thousand  
12 dollars (\$1,000) to assist the following counties with their Kids Voting  
13 programs: Alleghany, Beaufort, Buncombe, Burke, Cabarrus, Catawba,  
14 Chowan, Clay, Cumberland, Davie, Durham, Forsyth, Greene, Guilford,  
15 Haywood, Henderson, Iredell, Jackson, Lee, Madison, Mecklenburg, New  
16 Hanover, Pitt, Randolph, and Wake.

17 **SECTION 2.** If a county that received funds under subdivision (2) of Section 1 of  
18 this act determines it does not need all of its funding, the county may remit any portion of the  
19 funds received to the State program for further expansion of the Kids Voting program to  
20 nonparticipating counties.

21 **SECTION 3.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2010.
