Short Title: DMV to Issue Special ID Cards/Special Cir. (Public) Sponsors: Senator Berger of Franklin. Referred to: Transportation. February 18, 2009 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO ISSUE A SPECIAL IDENTIFICATION CARD, FREE OF CHARGE, TO INDIVIDUALS THAT HAVE A VALID DRIVERS LICENSE THAT IS REVOKED BASED ON AN ADMINISTRATIVE DECISION REGARDING MEDICAL DISQUALIFICATION. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** Chapter 20 of the General Statutes is amended by adding a new section to read: "§ 20-15.2. Special Identification cards to be issued when a license has been canceled by the Division for reasons related to a medical or physical condition. The Division shall issue a Special Identification card, at no cost, to any person who has been issued a drivers license but, as a result of a medical or physical condition, the license has been canceled by the Division. The Special Identification card issued as a result of a cancellation based on a medical or physical condition shall be valid for a period of time not to exceed the expiration date of the license canceled by the Division."

SECTION 2. This act is effective when it becomes law.
