A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT TO MAKE THE THEFT OF REGULATED METALS AFFIXED TO REAL PROPERTY A FELONY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

**SECTION 1.** G.S. 14-72(b) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:

"(b) The crime of larceny is a felony, without regard to the value of the property in question, if the larceny is any of the following:

...

(6) Of any regulated metals property, as defined by G.S. 66-11(a)(2), which is affixed to or part of any real property."

**SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective December 1, 2009, and applies to offenses committed on or after that date.
