The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:				
SECTION 1. Part 1 of Article 21 of Chapter 143 of the General Statutes is				
amended by adding a new section to read:				
"§ 143-214.19. Delineation of protective riparian buffers for coastal wetlands in the Neuse				
River and Tar-Pamlico River Basins.				
<u>(a)</u>	The f	ollowing definitions apply in this section:		
	<u>(1)</u>	Coastal wetlands. – Any salt marsh or other marsh subject to re		
		occasional flooding by tides, including wind tides (whether or not		
		waters reach the marshland areas through natural or artificial water	courses),	
	(2)	provided this shall not include hurricane or tropical storm tides.		
(1.)	(<u>2</u>)	Marshlands. – The term has the same meaning as G.S. 113-229(n).		
(b) If State law requires a protective riparian buffer for coastal wetlands in either the				
Neuse River Basin or the Tar-Pamlico River Basin, the coastal wetlands and marshlands shall				
not be treated as part of the surface waters but instead shall be included in the measurement of				
the protective riparian buffer. The protective riparian buffer for any of the coastal wetlands or marshlands in the Neuse River Basin or the Tar-Pamlico River Basin shall be delineated as				
follows:
