## A JOINT RESOLUTION TO MODIFY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 85 TO DELETE THE 1 2 PROPOSED CREATION OF A DIVISION OF PREVENTION, ACCESS AND PUBLIC 3 HEALTH SERVICES.

4 Whereas, Section 5(10) of Article III of the North Carolina Constitution states: 5 "Administrative reorganization. The General Assembly shall prescribe the functions, powers, and duties of the administrative departments and agencies of the State and may alter them from 6 7 time to time, but the Governor may make such changes in the allocation of offices and agencies 8 and in the allocation of those functions, powers, and duties as he considers necessary for 9 efficient administration. If those changes affect existing law, they shall be set forth in executive 10 orders, which shall be submitted to the General Assembly not later than the sixtieth calendar day of its session, and shall become effective and shall have the force of law upon adjournment 11 sine die of the session, unless specifically disapproved by resolution of either house of the 12 General Assembly or specifically modified by joint resolution of both houses of the General 13 Assembly"; and 14

15 Whereas, on March 25, 2011, the Governor issued Executive Order No. 85, entitled "CONSOLIDATION AND REORGANIZATION OF EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCIES 16 17 TO IMPROVE THE EFFICIENCY OF STATE GOVERNMENT," which recited that it was 18 issued under Section 5(10) of Article III of the North Carolina Constitution; Now, therefore,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring: 19

SECTION 1. Executive Order No. 85, dated March 25, 2011, and entitled 20 21 "CONSOLIDATION AND REORGANIZATION OF EXECUTIVE BRANCH AGENCIES 22 TO IMPROVE THE EFFICIENCY OF STATE GOVERNMENT" is modified pursuant to 23 Section 5 of Article III of the North Carolina Constitution by deleting the provisions of Section 24 7 of the Executive Order that proposed to create the Division of Prevention, Access and Public 25 Health Services. 26

**SECTION 2.** This resolution is effective upon ratification.
