Sec. 6 of this act is effective when it becomes law. The remainder of the act 9 becomes effective February 1, 2011, and but G.S. 14-415.4(1), as enacted by Section 1 of this 10

becomes effective February 1, 2011, and but G.S. 14-415.4(1), as enacted by Section 1 of this act, applies to offenses committed on or after that date. Prosecutions for offenses committed before the effective date of this act are not abated or affected by this act, and the statutes that would be applicable but for this act remain applicable to those prosecutions."

**SECTION 2.** This act is effective when it becomes law.
