8	(a) School Calendar. – Each local board of education shall adopt a school calendar	ar
9	consisting of 215 days all of which shall fall within the fiscal year. A school calendar sha	.11
10	include the following:	
11	(1) A minimum of <u>either 180 days and or 1,000 hours of instruction covering</u>	at
12	least nine calendar months. The local board shall designate when the 18	60
13	instructional days or 1,000 hours shall occur. The number of instruction	
14	hours in an instructional day may vary according to local board policy an	ıd
15	does not have to be uniform among the schools in the administrative uni	t.
16	Local boards may approve school improvement plans that include days wit	th
17	varying amounts of instructional time. If school is closed early due t	to
18	inclement weather, the day and the scheduled amount of instructional hour	rs
19	may count towards the required minimum to the extent allowed by Stat	
20	Board policy. The school calendar shall include a plan for making up day	
21	and instructional hours missed when schools are not opened due t	0
22	inclement weather.	
23	If, due to inclement weather, a local board of education complies with	
24	this subdivision by scheduling 1,000 hours of instruction on less than 18	
25	days, the local school administrative unit is deemed to have a minimum of	
26	180 days of instruction, teachers employed for a 10-month term are deeme	
27	to have been employed for 180 instructional days, and all other employee	
28	shall be compensated as if they had worked their regularly scheduled hour	rs
29	for 180 instructional days."	
30	SECTION 2. This act applies only to Dixon Elementary, Middle, and Hig	-
31	Schools located in Onslow County and applies only in the 2010-2011 school year for day	/S
32	missed due to a declared state of emergency.	
33	SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law.
