1	SECTION 2.(d) Proposals submitted under this section shall not be subject to
2	public inspection until a contract is awarded.
3	SECTION 2.(e) This act applies only to Mecklenburg County.
4	SECTION 3. Section 3 of S.L. 2009-149, as rewritten by S.L. 2010-57 and S.L.
5	2010-63, reads as rewritten:
6	"SECTION 3. Section 2 of this act applies to the Cities of Asheville, Raleigh and
7	Winston-Salem and the Towns of Chapel Hill and Carrboro only. This act also applies to
8	Catawba County.and Mecklenburg Counties."
9	SECTION 4. This act is effective when it becomes law.
