3	PREEXISTING SWINE FARMS BY PROVIDING FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OR				
4	RENOVATION OF SWINE HOUSES AT THOSE FARMS.				
5	Whereas, the General Assembly finds that the swine industry makes in	mportant			
6	contributions to the people and economy of North Carolina; and	1			
7	Whereas, the General Assembly finds that facilitating the improvem	ent and			
8	upgrading of swine farms within North Carolina through the construction and renov				
9	swine houses at certain preexisting swine farms can provide benefits to the well-being of the				
10	animals at the farms, while maintaining and enhancing the ability of those swine farms to				
11	remain competitive and to protect the environment; Now, therefore,				
12	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:				
13	SECTION 1. Article 67 of Chapter 106 of the General Statutes is ame	nded by			
14	adding a new section to read:				
15	"§ 106-806. Construction or renovation of swine houses at preexisting swine farms	5.			
16	(a) Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Article, a swine house t	hat is a			
17	component of a preexisting swine farm can be constructed or renovated so long	g as the			
18	construction or renovation of that swine house satisfies all of the following requirement	<u>s:</u>			
19	(1) The construction or renovation of the swine house does not resu	<u>ilt in an</u>			
20	increase in the permitted capacity of the swine farm, as measure	d in the			
21	annual steady state live weight capacity of the swine farm.				
22	(2) The construction or renovation of the swine house does not a	result in			
23	requiring an increase in the total permitted capacity of the anim	<u>al waste</u>			
24	management systems located at the swine farm.				
25	(3) For any swine house that fails to meet any siting requirement for	a swine			
26	house under G.S. 106-803, the construction or renovation of the swit				
27	does not, subject to subsection (b) of this section, result in any portion				
28	constructed or renovated swine house being located any closer				
29	building or the property that is the object of the siting requirement	that the			
30	swine house fails to meet.				
31	(b) A swine house that is a component of a preexisting swine farm can be con				
32	or renovated such that it results in a portion of the constructed or renovated swine hou				
33	located closer to a residence, school, hospital, church, or a property boundary than is				
34	under subdivision (3) of subsection (a) of this section if written permission is given	<u>n by the</u>			
35	owner of the property and recorded with the register of deeds.

2		(1)	'New swine farm' means any swine farm the operations of	which were sited			
3			on or after October 1, 1995. 'New swine farm' does				
4			preexisting swine farm, even if a subsequent site evaluation				
5			or after October 1, 1995, at the preexisting swine farm.	-			
6		<u>(2)</u>	'Preexisting swine farm' means any swine farm either t	he operations of			
7			which were begun prior to October 1, 1995, or the site eva	aluation of which			
8			was approved prior to October 1, 1995, by the Departmen	t of Environment			
9			and Natural Resources under Part 1A of Article 21 of Ch	napter 143 of the			
10			General Statutes.				
11		<u>(3)</u>	'Renovation or construction,' 'renovated or constructed,'	and any similar			
12			phrase mean any activity to renovate, construct, reconstruct	<u>, rebuild, modify,</u>			
13			alter, change, restructure, upgrade, improve, expand, re	educe, move, or			
14			otherwise perform construction work on a swine house that	<u>it is a component</u>			
15			<u>of a swine farm.</u>				
16	<u>(d)</u>	This s	ection does not apply to the construction or renovation of a sy	wine house that is			
17	<u>a compon</u>	ent of a	new swine farm."

19	constructions or renovations that occur on or after that date.
