1	A HOUSE RESOLUTION OBSERVING THE TWO HUNDRED THIRTY-FIFTH
2	ANNIVERSARY OF THE HALIFAX RESOLVES.
3	Whereas, on April 4, 1776, North Carolina's Fourth Provincial Congress reconvened
4	in Halifax, North Carolina, and soon after appointed a committee to consider additional actions
5	to defend the colony against King George III and the British Parliament; and
6	Whereas, the committee included Cornelius Harnett, Allen Jones, Thomas Burke,
7	and Abner Nash; and
8	Whereas, on April 12, 1776, the committee submitted a resolution to the Provincial
9	Congress for consideration; and
10	Whereas, the resolution, which became known as the "Halifax Resolves," directed
11	North Carolina's delegates to the Second Continental Congress to vote for independence from
12	Britain, to join the other colonies in declaring independence, and to reserve the right for North
13	Carolina to create a constitution; and
14	Whereas, the 83 delegates present unanimously adopted the Halifax Resolves; and
15	Whereas, North Carolina was the first colony to officially encourage independence
16	from Britain, which was soon followed by other colonies adopting similar resolutions; and
17	Whereas, adoption of the Halifax Resolves is considered one of the most important
18	events in North Carolina's history; and
19	Whereas, the date "April 12, 1776" appears as part of North Carolina's flag; and
20	Whereas, 2011 marks the 235 <sup>th</sup> anniversary of the adoption of the Halifax Resolves;
21	Now, therefore,
22	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives:
23	SECTION 1. The House of Representatives wishes to pay tribute to Cornelius
24	Harnett, Allen Jones, Thomas Burke, Abner Nash, and the other delegates to North Carolina's
25	Fourth Provincial Congress for their brave action in seeking independence from Britain by
26	adopting the Halifax Resolves.
27	<b>SECTION 2.</b> The House of Representatives encourages the citizens of this State to
28	learn more about North Carolina's Fourth Provincial Congress and their actions and to observe
29	the 235 <sup>th</sup> anniversary of the adoption of the Halifax Resolves.
30	<b>SECTION 3.</b> This resolution is effective upon adoption.
