4 Whereas, Anson County ranks 22nd statewide in agriculturally based income; and 5 Whereas, preliminary plans have been drawn for the construction of an agri-civic

6 center to be located in the county seat of Wadesboro; and

- Whereas, the new facility would have a 1,000-capacity auditorium and 22,000 square feet for office space to house all of the County's agriculture agencies under one roof and provide adequate space for meetings and; and
- Whereas, the agri-civic center will be able to host district and regional conferences,
 both private and public, and will serve as a catalyst for economic development; and
 Whereas, the agri-civic center will cost approximately \$10 million; and
- Whereas, the agricerve center will cost approximately \$10 million, and Whereas, funding for the new facility includes a pledge of \$2.5 million from Anson County and \$2.5 million from pledges from local foundations, grants, and individuals; Now, therefore,
- 16 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
- 17 **SECTION 1.** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Anson County the 18 sum of five million dollars (\$5,000,000) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year to help fund the County's 19 Agri-Civic Center.
- 20 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2012.
