A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO REDUCE CLASS SIZE IN KINDERGARTEN
- 3 THROUGH THIRD GRADE.
- 4 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:

5 SECTION 1. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of 6 Public Instruction the sum of ninety-two million eight hundred eighty-five thousand eight 7 hundred seventy-seven dollars (\$92,885,877) for the 2012-2013 fiscal year to reduce class size 8 in kindergarten through third grade. Notwithstanding G.S. 115C-301 or any other law, local 9 school administrative units shall have the maximum flexibility to use these additional teacher 10 positions to maximize student achievement in kindergarten through third grade.

11 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective July 1, 2012.
