Savings shall be affected where the total amounts 12 appropriated are not required to perform these services and accomplish these purposes, and the 13 14 savings shall revert to the appropriate fund at the end of each fiscal year, except as otherwise 15 provided by law. 16 17 **TITLE OF ACT** 18 SECTION 1.2.
