 THE DIVISION OF MOTOR VEHICLES TO INDIVIDUALS WHO ARE LEGALLY
 PRESENT IN THE UNITED STATES FOR A LIMITED DURATION OF TIME TO
 ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH THE REAL ID ACT OF 2005.
- 6 The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
 - **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-7(s) reads as rewritten:

Notwithstanding the requirements of subsection (b1) of this section that an applicant 8 "(s) 9 present a valid social security number, the Division shall issue a drivers license of limited duration, under subsection (f) of this section, to an applicant present in the United States who 10 holds valid documentation issued by, or under the authority of, the United States government 11 that demonstrates the applicant's legal presence of limited duration in the United States if the 12 applicant presents that valid documentation and meets all other requirements for a license of 13 14 limited duration. Notwithstanding the requirements of subsection (n) of this section addressing background colors and borders, a person issued a drivers license of limited duration under this 15 section who is 21 years of age or older shall have a red background or border." 16 SECTION 2. This act becomes effective August 1, 2011, and applies to drivers 17

18 licenses issued on or after that date.
