7	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
8	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-7(s) reads as rewritten:
9	"(s) Notwithstanding the requirements of subsection (b1) of this section that an applicant
10	present a valid social security number, the Division shall issue a drivers license of limited
11	duration, under subsection (f) of this section, to an applicant present in the United States who
12	holds valid documentation issued by, or under the authority of, the United States government
13	that demonstrates the applicant's legal presence of limited duration in the United States if the
14	applicant presents that valid documentation and meets all other requirements for a license of
15	limited duration. Notwithstanding the requirements of subsection (n) of this section addressing
16	background colors and borders, a person issued a drivers license of limited duration under this
17	section who is 21 years of age or older shall bear a distinguishing mark or other designation on
18	the face of the license clearly denoting the limited duration of the license."

19 **SECTION 2.** This act becomes effective August 1, 2011, and applies to drivers 20 licenses issued on or after that date.
