The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: **SECTION 1.** G.S. 20-63(b) reads as rewritten:

5 "(b) Every license plate must display the registration number assigned to the vehicle for 6 which it is issued, the name of the State of North Carolina, which may be abbreviated, and the 7 year number for which it is issued or the date of expiration. A plate issued for a commercial 8 vehicle, as defined in G.S. 20-4.2(1), and weighing 26,001 pounds or more, must bear the word 9 "commercial," unless the plate is a special registration plate authorized in G.S. 20-79.4 or the commercial vehicle is a trailer or is licensed for 6,000 pounds or less. The plate issued for 10 11 vehicles licensed for 7,000 pounds through 26,000 pounds must bear the word "weighted," 12 unless the plate is a special registration plate authorized in G.S. 20-79.4.

13 Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, a registration plate issued by the Division 14 for a private passenger vehicle or for a private hauler vehicle licensed for 6,000 pounds or less shall be a "First in Flight" plate. A "First in Flight" plate shall have the words "First in Flight" 15 printed at the top of the plate above all other letters and numerals. The background of the plate 16 17 shall depict the Wright Brothers biplane flying over Kitty Hawk Beach, with the plane flying slightly upward and to the right. The following special Special registration plates do not have to 18 be a "First in Flight" plate. The Division shall develop, in consultation with the State Highway 19 20 Patrol and the Department of Correction, a standardized format for special registration plates. The format shall allow for the license plate to be read easily by the human eye and by cameras 21 installed along roadways as part of a tolling, red-light, or speed enforcement program. A 22 23 designated portion of the plate shall be used for any unique design or logo representing the group or interest for which the Division is authorized to produce the special registration plate. 24 The design of the plates that are not "First in Flight" plates must be approved by the Division 25 26 and the State Highway Patrol for clarity and ease of identification.
