8	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:		
9	SECTION 1. G.S. 20-347(d) is amended by adding a new subdivision to read:		
10	" <u>((</u>	5) <u>A vehicle that is sold by a manufacturer directly to a State agen</u>	<u>ncy, a unit of</u>
11	local government, a volunteer fire department, or a volunteer rescue squad in		
12	conformity with federal government contract specifications."		
13	SECTION 2. G.S. 105-187.3(b) reads as rewritten:		
14	"(b) Retail Value. – The retail value of a motor vehicle for which a certificate of title is		
15	issued because of a sale of the motor vehicle by a retailer is the sales price of the motor vehicle,		
16	including all accessories attached to the vehicle when it is delivered to the purchaser, less the		
17	amount of any allowance given by the retailer for a motor vehicle taken in trade as a full or		
18	partial payment for the purchased motor vehicle.		
19	The retail value of a motor vehicle for which a certificate of title is issued because of a sale		
20	of the motor vehicle by a seller who is not a retailer is the market value of the vehicle, less the		
21	amount of any allowance given by the seller for a motor vehicle taken in trade as a full or		
22	partial payment for the purchased motor vehicle. A transaction in which two parties exchange		
23	motor vehicles is considered a sale regardless of whether either party gives additional		
24		as part of the transaction.
