10	The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts:
11	SECTION 1. G.S. 62-133.8(b)(2) reads as rewritten:
12	"(2) An electric public utility may meet the requirements of this section by any
13	one or more of the following:
14	•••
15	c. Reduce energy consumption through the implementation of an
16	energy efficiency measure; provided, however, an electric public
17	utility subject to the provisions of this subsection may shall meet up
18	to twenty-five percent (25%) and no more of the requirements of this
19	section through savings due to implementation of energy efficiency
20	measures. Beginning in calendar year 2021 and each year thereafter,
21	an electric public utility may shall meet up to forty percent (40%)
22	and no more of the requirements of this section through savings due
23	to implementation of energy efficiency measures.
