A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT TO ELIMINATE THE WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS ON FARM TRUCKS OR VEHICLES TRAVELLING ON A LIGHT-TRAFFIC ROAD. The General Assembly of North Carolina enacts: SECTION 1. G.S. 20-118(c)(4) reads as rewritten: "(4) A truck or other motor vehicle shall be exempt from such light-traffic road limitations provided for pursuant to G.S. 20-118(b)(4), when transporting supplies, material or equipment necessary to carry out a farmingany operation engaged in the production of meats and agricultural crops and livestock or poultry by products or a business engaged in the harvest or processing of seafood—when the destination of such vehicle and load is located solely upon said light-traffic road." SECTION 2. G.S. 20-118(c)(5) is repealed. SECTION 3. This act is effective when it becomes law. Prosecutions for offenses committed before the effective date of this act are not abated or affected by this act, and the statutes that would be applicable but for this act remain applicable to those prosecutions.
